## **B. TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION**

### **1. Rationale**

Our country is now facing problems, struggles and crisis amid the covid 19 pandemic that greatly affect people's livelihood, health and our food system. It is highly likely that the COVID-19 pandemic will result in increased hunger and poverty. Times like these remind us all the importance of ensuring our nation's food security. In support to the program of Department of Agriculture, headed by Secretary William D. Dar, Department Secretary, to the new program HVCDP Agriculture Stimulus Package BAYANIHAN II, one of the focus of the program is to increase domestic food production to increase levels of the productivity across all commodities and thus ensure food productivity, availability affordability amidst the threat of covid-19 pandemic. It also promotes massive food production through urban or backyard food production in the community.

Agriculture sector plays a key role in mitigating the effects of the pandemic on food production, market access, and rural employment. Economic growth in agriculture is more effective at reducing poverty and food insecurity than growth in other sectors. Investments in agriculture can help revive food production and create jobs, following a crisis, and enable rural communities to recover.

With the unity of the community, we hope to improve our productivity and supply chain across the region/country.

## **2. General Objective**

To increase food production, ensure availability, affordability of lowland vegetables amidst the covid-19 pandemic.

Specific:

To establish a Nursery both Inside the University and at the barangay level

- To produce 200 kilograms open-pollinated variety vegetable seeds.
- To produce 200,000 pieces vegetable seedlings.
- To distribute 200 kilograms open-pollinated variety vegetable
- To distribute 200,000 pieces vegetable seedlings.
- To serve 10,000 household beneficiaries of vegetables seeds
- To promote massive food production through backyard gardening.

## **3. General Methodology**

The project will be implemented in the 64 barangays in the municipality of Echague, Isabela. This Project will be undertaken through the following components;

**1. Nursery Establishment.** Nursery establishment inside the University and at the barangay level. Existing nursery of the Dep Ed school will be utilized so that parents and school children as members of the PTA Association can be tapped as partners of the project with the barangay officials and household beneficiaries to produce the seedlings distributed by the University at the same time they will also produce at their own so that this will ensure sustainability of the project.

**2. Production and Distribution OPV Seeds and seedlings.** Materials need for vegetable production will be provided by the proponent and for the assurance of proper implementation of the management practices of each commodity of the lowland vegetable (pinakbet type).

**3. Capability Building/ Trainings on Vegetables Production Technologies.** Training for the package of technology will be required for this activity. Barangay officials or a group of women that will supervise the operation of the gulayan sa barangay and lowland vegetable growers in the area will be organized and trained. Experts from the College of Agriculture on vegetable technologies will be invited as Resource Persons.

**4. Livelihood Enterprise Development.** An Association of Vegetable Growers will be organized and will be trained into a livelihood enterprise development. Their produce will be sold and displayed at the Mengal Women Center where products of the barangays through the women's association are sold and promoted. Produced will also be sold for the constituents of the barangay as income generating enterprise of the barangay and serve as capital for the next season production and for the assurance of sustainability.

#### **ACTIVITIES AND STRATEGIES**

- **Procurement of materials.** All the materials needed in the project will be procured immediately to ensure the smooth flow of the implementation of the project.
- **Establishment of potting shed and seed storage.** It will serve as the working area in preparing vegetable seedlings and also to store open-pollinated variety seeds.

- **Enhancement of greenhouses.** Greenhouse is very important in the production of vegetable seedlings. Some of the advantage is, it will control the environment, insect pests and diseases to produce healthy seedlings.
- **Raising of vegetable seedlings and producing open-pollinated variety seeds.** Extensive care and management will be given to produce a healthy and free from pest and diseases seed and seedlings.
- **Conduct trainings.** All household beneficiaries in the barangay who will be given seeds and seedlings are required to attend the training. This will ensure the proper operation of producing and care and management of the plants.
- **Monitoring and Evaluation.** Monitoring and evaluation must be periodically done to ensure the smooth and effective implementation of the project. To ensure efficient and effective project implementation, on-site /field monitoring of distributed seedlings and seeds of vegetables projects will be done to find out if the project has been implemented and target production will be met.
- **Progress/ Terminal Report Submission.** All documented projects reports by quarter will be submitted to DA regional Office as well as the Terminal Report after the project implementation.

- Produced 200,000 pieces vegetable seedlings.
- Distributed 200 kilograms open-pollinated variety vegetable



**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agriculture recognizes that the State Universities and Colleges within its regional jurisdiction have the sufficient infrastructure and capacity to produce planting materials and seedlings;
